# INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REVIEW REPORT ON REVIEW OF INTERIM STANDALONE FINANCIAL RESULTS

### TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF HINDUSTAN OIL EXPLORATION COMPANY LIMITED

- 1. We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of Standalone Unaudited Financial Results of **HINDUSTAN OIL EXPLORATION COMPANY LIMITED** ("the Company"), which includes seven unincorporated joint ventures, consolidated on a proportionate basis for the quarter and six months ended September 30, 2020 ("the Statement"), being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended.
- 2. This Statement, which is the responsibility of the Company's Management and approved by the Company's Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" ("Ind AS 34"), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on the Statement based on our review.
- 3. We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410 'Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity', issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI). A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of the Company's personnel responsible for financial and accounting matters and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Standards on Auditing specified under section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013 and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.
- 4. Based on our review conducted as stated in paragraph 3 above, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Statement, prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the aforesaid Indian Accounting Standard and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.
- 5. We draw attention to Note 3 of the standalone financial results which describes the management's assessment of the impact of the outbreak of Covid-19. The management believes that no adjustments are required in the financial results as of the current quarter end. Such estimates are based on current facts and circumstances and may not necessarily reflect the future uncertainties and events arising from the full impact of the COVID 19 pandemic.

Our report is not modified in respect of this matter.



6. A. We did not review the interim financial information of four unincorporated joint ventures included in the Statement whose interim financial information reflect, to the extent of Company's proportionate interest, total assets of ₹ 1,087 lakhs as at September 30, 2020 and total revenue of ₹ 96 Lakhs and ₹ 168 Lakhs for the quarter and six months ended September 30, 2020 respectively. The interim financial information of these unincorporated joint ventures have been incorporated on the basis of information available with the company. Our conclusion in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these unincorporated joint ventures, is based solely on such interim financial information available with the company. According to the information and explanations given to us by the management, these interim financial information is not material to the Company.

B. We have placed reliance on technical/commercial evaluation by the management in respect of categorization of the oil wells as exploratory, development, producing and dry wells, allocation of costs incurred on them, proven developed hydrocarbon reserves and depletion thereof on the Oil and Gas assets, impairment and liability for site restoration costs.

Our conclusion on the Statement is not modified in respect of these matters.

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Notes:-

- 1. The above un-audited standalone financial results for the quarter and six months ended September 30, 2020 have been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" ("Ind AS 34") as prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, which were reviewed and recommended by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at its meeting held on November 11, 2020. The statutory auditors of the Company have carried out limited review of the results of the quarter and six months ended.
- The individual items of expenses in the above financial results are net of amounts charged to Unincorporated Joint Ventures (UJV) where the Company is the operator. The Company's share of such net expenses in UJV's are treated as exploration, development or production costs, as the case may be.
- 3. The Company is in the business of exploration, development and production of crude oil and natural gas in India. Production of crude oil and gas is classified as essential commodities as per Section 2 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955. Presently, gas and oil production of the Company at Dirok field in Assam, PY-1 field in Cauvery offshore and three fields in Gujarat are under production as per the offtakes of the buyers. In assessing the recoverability of its assets including receivables and inventory, the Company has considered internal and external information up to the date of approval of these financial results including economic forecasts. The Company has performed analysis on the assumptions used and based on current indicators of future economic conditions, the Company expects to recover the carrying amount of these assets. The Company has concluded that there is no impact of COVID-19 based on such evaluation. The impact of the global health pandemic may be different from that estimated as at the date of approval of these financial results and the Company will continue to closely monitor any material changes to future economic conditions.
- 4. Production Sharing Contract ("PSC") for PY1 block was granted extension to continue the production up to January 4, 2021 by Government of India ("GOI") while the addendum to the PSC for 10 years extension is being processed for execution by GOI. With regard to the dispute by GOI on short payment royalty and the claim of excess payment by the company, is now being agreed to refer to the Dispute Resolution Committee for resolution. Accordingly, an amount of ₹ 300 lacs was paid under protest towards the GOI claim of additional royalty of ₹ 1,301.11 lacs. This payment of ₹ 300 lacs though a part of the dispute resolution is accounted as expenses in the current quarter.
- 5. The Company operates in one segment i.e. "Oil and Gas".
- 6. Figures for previous quarters/ six months ended have been regrouped/reclassified wherever necessary to confirm to the current quarter/ six months ended presentation.

We did not review the interim financial information of one subsidiary included in the Statement, whose interim financial information reflect total Assets of ₹ 21,717 lakhs as at September 30, 2020, total revenues of ₹ 302 lakhs and ₹ 533 for the quarter and six months ended September 30, 2020 respectively, total net profit after tax and total comprehensive income of ₹ 143 lakhs and ₹ 61 Lakhs for the quarter and six months ended September 30, 2020 which includes group's share of profit of ₹ 37 lakhs and ₹ 40 Lakhs for the quarter and six months ended September 30, 2020 and net cash inflows of ₹ 21 lakhs for the six months ended September 30, 2020, as considered in the Statement. 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Notes:-

 The above un-audited consolidated results of the Company and its subsidiaries (the Company and its subsidiaries together referred to as "Group") for the quarter and six months ended September 30, 2020 have been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" ("Ind AS 34") as prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, which were reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at their meetings held on November 11, 2020. The statutory auditors of the company have carried out limited review of the results of the quarter and six months ended.

The consolidated results for the quarter and six months ended September 30,2020 include the results of the Group's subsidiaries of Hindage Oilfield Services Limited ("HOSL') and Geopetrol International Inc. ("GPII"). It also includes the stepdown subsidiary Geopetrol Mauritius Limited ("GML") and an associate of GML, GeoEnpro Petroleum Limited ("GeoEnpro").

- The individual items of expenses in the above financial results are net of amounts charged to Unincorporated Joint Ventures (UJV) where the Group is the operator. The Group's share of such net expenses in UJV's are treated as exploration, development or production costs, as the case may be.
- 3. The Group is in the business of exploration, development and production of crude oil and natural gas in India. Production of crude oil and gas is classified as essential commodities as per Section 2 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955. Presently, gas and oil production of the Company at Dirok field in Assam and Kharsang field in Arunachal Pradesh, PY-1 field in Cauvery offshore and three fields in Gujarat are under production as per the offtakes of the buyers. In assessing the recoverability of its assets including receivables and inventory, the group has considered internal and external information up to the date of approval of these financial results including economic forecasts. The Group has performed analysis on the assumptions used and based on current indicators of future economic conditions, the Group expects to recover the carrying amount of these assets. The Group has concluded that there is no impact of COVID-19 based on such evaluation. The impact of the global health pandemic may be different from that estimated as at the date of approval of these financial and the Group will continue to closely monitor any material changes to future economic conditions.
- 4 Production Sharing Contract ("PSC") for PY1 block was granted extension to continue the production up to January 4, 2021 by Government of India ("GOI") while the addendum to the PSC for 10 years extension is being processed for execution by GOI. With regard to the dispute by GOI on short payment royalty and the claim of excess payment by the company, is now being agreed to refer to the Dispute Resolution Committee for resolution. Accordingly, an amount of ₹ 300 lacs was paid under protest towards the GOI claim of additional royalty of ₹ 1,301.11 lacs. This payment of ₹ 300 lacs though a part of the dispute resolution is accounted as expenses in the current quarter.
- 5. Production Sharing Contract for Kharsang block, wherein Geopetrol holds 25% participating interest has expired on 15 June 2020 and got extension for 5 months from Government of India to continue the production till a formal extension of 10 years is granted effective 15 June 2020. The formal extension is being pursued by the operator by settling the outstanding issues with the Directorate General of Hydrocarbons based on the Management Committee meeting held on 15 June 2020.
- 6. The Group operates in one segment i.e. "Oil and Gas".
- 7. Figures for previous quarters/six months ended have been regrouped/reclassified wherever necessary to confirm to the current quarter presentation.
