NOTICE OF THE 42ND ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

NOTICE is hereby given that the **Forty Second Annual General Meeting (AGM)** of the **Members of Hindustan Oil Exploration Company Limited** will be held on **Friday, the 25th day of September 2026 at 11:00 a.m.** through Video Conferencing ("VC") / Other Audio-Visual Means ("OAVM"), to transact the following businesses:

ORDINARY BUSINESS

1. To receive, consider and adopt:
 - (a) the audited standalone financial statements of the Company for the financial year ended March 31, 2026 together with the reports of the Board of Directors and the Auditors thereon; and
 - (b) the audited consolidated financial statements of the Company for the financial year ended March 31, 2026 together with the reports of the Auditors thereon.
2. To appoint a director in place of Mr. Ashok Kumar Goel (DIN: 00025350) who retires by rotation and being eligible, offers himself for re-appointment.

SPECIAL BUSINESS

3. To consider increase in borrowing limits of the Company from ₹ 750 Crores to ₹ 1,000 Crores
To consider and, if thought fit, to pass with or without modification(s), the following Resolution as a **Special Resolution**:

"RESOLVED that in supersession of the earlier resolution passed by the members at the 40th Annual General Meeting of the Company held on September 26, 2024, and pursuant to the provisions of Section 180(1)(c) and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 and Rules framed thereunder, as amended from time to time, consent of the members of the Company be and is hereby accorded to the Board of Directors (hereinafter referred to as "Board" which term shall be deemed to include any Committee which the Board may have constituted or hereinafter constitute, to exercise its powers, including the powers conferred by this resolution) to borrow from time to time, any sum or sums of monies which together with the monies already borrowed by the Company (apart from temporary loans obtained or to be obtained from the Company's bankers in the ordinary course of business) may exceed the aggregate of the paid-up capital, free reserves and securities premium of the Company, provided that the total amount so borrowed by the Board shall not at any time exceed ₹ 1,000 Crores (Rupees Thousand Crores only) or the aggregate of the paid-up capital, free reserves and securities premium of the Company, whichever is higher:

5. To make investments, give loans, guarantees and security in excess of limits specified under Section 186 of the Companies Act, 2013

To consider and, if thought fit, to pass with or without modification(s), the following Resolution as a **Special Resolution**:

RESOLVED that pursuant to the provisions of Section 186 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 and relevant rules made thereunder, as amended from time to time, and in accordance with the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company, approval of the Members of the Company be and is hereby accorded to the Board of Directors of the Company (hereinafter referred to as the "Board" which term shall be deemed to include any Committee which the Board may have constituted or hereinafter constitute, to exercise its powers, including the powers conferred by this resolution) to (a) give any loan to any person or other body corporate; (b) give any guarantee or provide security in connection with a loan to any other body corporate or person; and (c) acquire by way of subscription, purchase or otherwise, the securities of any other body corporate from time to time in one or more tranches as the Board of Directors in their absolute discretion deem beneficial and in the interest of the Company, for an amount not exceeding ₹ 300 crores (Rupees Three Hundred Crores Only), notwithstanding that such investments, outstanding loans given or to be given and guarantees and/or security provided may collectively exceed the limits prescribed under Section 186 of the Companies Act, 2013.

Suryanarayanan, Cost Accountant in Practice (Membership no. 24946), who, on the recommendation of the Audit Committee, has been appointed by the Board of Directors as the Cost Auditor of the Company, to conduct the audit of the cost records maintained by the Company for the financial year 2026-27.

The Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) has, vide General Circular No. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020, Circular No. 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, General Circular No. 20/2020 dated May 5, 2020, General Circular No. 22/2020 dated June 15, 2020, General Circular No. 33/2020 dated September 28, 2020, General Circular No. 39/2020 dated December 31, 2020, General Circular No. 02/2021 dated January 13, 2021, General Circular No. 10/2021 dated June 23, 2021, General Circular No. 20/2021 dated December 8, 2021, General Circular No. 02/2022 dated May 05, 2022, General Circular No. 10/2022 dated December 28, 2022, General Circular No. 9/2023 dated September 25, 2023, General Circular No. 09/2024 dated 19/09/ 2024 and 03/2025 dated September 22, 2025 (collectively "MCA Circulars") and SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CFD-PoD-2/P/CIR/2024/133 dated October 3, 2024, SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/PoD-2/P/CIR/2023/4 dated January 5, 2023 read with SEBI Master Circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD2/ CIR /P/2021/11 dated January 15, 2021 and Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD1/CIR/P/2020/79 dated May 12, 2020 (Collectively "SEBI Circulars"), permitted companies to conduct Annual General Meeting (AGM) through Video Conferencing (VC) or Other Audio Visual Means (OAVM), subject to compliance of various conditions mentioned therein. In compliance with the MCA and SEBI Circulars and applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act") and SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("SEBI Listing Regulations"), the 42nd AGM of the Company is being convened and conducted through VC / OAVM. The registered office of the Company shall be deemed to be the venue for the AGM.



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2. In compliance with the aforesaid MCA Circulars and SEBI Circulars, the Notice of the AGM along with the Annual Report for FY 2025-26 is being sent only through electronic mode to those Members whose email addresses are registered with the Company / Depositories. Members may note that the Notice and the Annual Report for FY 2025-26 will also be available on the Company's website www.hoec.com, websites of the Stock Exchanges i.e. BSE Limited and National Stock Exchange of India Limited at www.bseindia.com and www.nseindia.com respectively, and on the website of CDSL <https://www.evotingindia.com/>.
3. The Explanatory Statement pursuant to Section 102 of the Act setting out material facts concerning the special business from Item No. 3 to 6 of the Notice is annexed hereto. Further, the relevant details with respect to Item No. 2 pursuant to Regulation 36(3) of the SEBI Listing Regulations and Secretarial Standards on General Meetings ("SS-2") issued by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India, in respect of Director seeking re-appointment at this AGM is also given as Annexure A.
4. A Member entitled to attend and vote at the AGM is entitled to appoint a proxy to attend and vote in the meeting instead of himself / herself. Since the 42nd AGM is being held through VC / OAVM as per the MCA Circulars, physical attendance of Members has been dispensed with. Accordingly, the facility for appointment of proxies by the Members will not be made available for the 42nd AGM and hence the Proxy Form, Attendance Slip and route map of AGM are not annexed to this Notice.
5. Institutional / Corporate Members are required to send to the Company a scanned copy (PDF/JPG Format) of its Board or governing body resolution / authorization etc., authorizing its representative to attend the AGM through VC / OAVM on its behalf and to vote through remote e-Voting.
6. The Company has notified the closure of Register of Members and Share Transfer Books from 19th September 2026 to 25th September 2026 (both days inclusive).
7. Members are requested to intimate changes, if any, pertaining to their name, postal address, e-mail address, telephone / mobile numbers, Permanent Account Number (PAN), mandates, nominations, power of attorney, etc., to their DPs if the shares are held by them in electronic form or if the shares are held in physical form to the Registrar and Share Transfer Agent ("RTA") - MUFG Intime India Private Limited (formerly known as Link Intime India Private Limited) at "Geetakunj", 1, Bhakti Nagar Society, Behind ABS Tower, Old Padra Road, Vadodara, Gujarat - 390015 ; Email ID: vadodara@in.mpms.mufg.com.
8. Members who have not registered their e-mail addresses so far are requested to register their e-mail address with DP / RTA - MUFG Intime India Private Limited for receiving all communication including Annual Report, Notices, Circulars, etc. from the Company electronically.
9. Members may please note that SEBI vide its Circular No. SEBI/HO/MIRSD/MIRSD RTAMB/P/CIR/2022/8 dated January 25, 2022 read with SEBI Master Circular No. SEBI/HO/MIRSD/POD-1/P/CIR/2024/37 dated May 07, 2024 has mandated the Listed Companies to issue securities in dematerialized form only while processing service requests viz. issue of duplicate securities certificate; claim from unclaimed suspense account; renewal / exchange of securities certificate; endorsement; sub-division / splitting of securities certificate; consolidation of securities certificates / folios; transmission and transposition. Accordingly, Members are requested to make service requests by submitting a duly filled and signed Form ISR - 4, the format of which is available on the website of the Company's RTA at www.in.mpms.mufg.com. It may be noted that any service request can be processed only after the folio is KYC Compliant.
10. In terms of Regulation 40(1) of SEBI Listing Regulations, as amended from time to time, transfer, transmission and transposition of securities shall be effected only in dematerialized form. In view of the same and to eliminate all risks associated with physical shares and avail various benefits of dematerialization, Members are advised to dematerialize the shares held by them in physical form. Members can contact the Company or RTA for assistance in this regard.



11. As per the provisions of Section 72 of the Act, the facility for making nomination is available for the Members in respect of the shares held by them. Members who have not yet registered their nomination are requested to register the same by submitting Form No. SH-13. If a Member desires to opt out or cancel the earlier nomination and record a fresh nomination, he/she may submit the same in Form ISR-3 or SH-14 as the case may be. The said forms can be downloaded from the Company's website at www.hoec.com and on the website of the Company's RTA at www.in.mpms.mufg.com. Members are requested to submit the said details to their DP in case the shares are held by them in dematerialized form and to RTA in case the shares are held in physical form.
12. Members / Beneficial owners are requested to quote their Ledger Folio No. / DP & Client ID No., as the case may be, in all correspondence with the Company. Members are also requested to quote their e-mail address, telephone, mobile and fax numbers for prompt reply to their communication.
13. Members are requested to note that dividends which were not claimed within seven years from the date of transfer to the Company's Unpaid Dividend Account and the corresponding shares on which dividend remains unclaimed for seven consecutive years have been transferred to the Investor Education and Protection Fund (IEPF) as per Section 124 of the Act and the applicable Rules. The same can be claimed back from IEPF by submitting an online application in the prescribed Form No. IEPF-5 available on the website www.iepf.gov.in and sending a physical copy of the same, duly signed to the Company / RTA, along with requisite documents enumerated in the Form No. IEPF-5.
14. SEBI vide Circular Nos. SEBI/HO/OIAE/OIAE_IAD-1/P/ CIR/2023/131 dated July 31, 2023, and SEBI/HO/OIAE/OIAE_IAD-1/P/CIR/2023/135 dated August 4, 2023, read with Master Circular No. SEBI/HO/ OIAE/OIAE_IAD-1/P/ CIR/2023/145 dated July 31, 2023 (updated as on December 28, 2023), has established a common Online Dispute Resolution Portal ("ODR Portal") for resolution of disputes arising in the Indian Securities Market. Pursuant to above-mentioned circulars, post exhausting the option to resolve their grievances with the RTA / Company directly and through existing SCORES platform, the investors can initiate dispute resolution through the ODR Portal <https://smartodr.in/login>.
15. Non-Resident Indian Members are requested to inform DP / RTA immediately of (a) change in their residential status on return to India for permanent settlement (b) particulars of their bank account maintained in India with complete name, branch, account type, account number and address of the bank with pin code number, if not furnished earlier.
16. In case of joint holders, the Member whose name appears as the first holder in the order of names as per the Register of Members of the Company as on the cut-off date will be entitled to vote during the AGM.
17. Members attending the 42nd AGM through VC/OAVM shall be counted for the purpose of reckoning the quorum under Section 103 of the Act.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR E-VOTING AND ATTENDING THE AGM THROUGH VC / OAVM

1. In compliance with the provisions of Section 108 of the Act, read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, as amended from time to time, and Regulation 44 of the SEBI Listing Regulations, the Members are provided with the facility to cast their vote electronically, on all the resolutions set forth in this Notice. The instructions for e-voting are given herein below.
2. The Board of Directors has appointed M/s. S. Sandeep & Associates, Practicing Company Secretaries as the Scrutinizer to scrutinize remote e-voting process and voting during the AGM in a fair and transparent manner.
3. In terms of SEBI circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated December 9, 2020 on e-Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants. Shareholders are advised to update their mobile number and email-ID in their demat accounts in order to access e-Voting facility.



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4. Members can join the AGM in the VC / OAVM mode 15 minutes before and after the scheduled time of the commencement of the Meeting by following the procedure mentioned in this Notice.
5. The voting period commences on **Sunday, September 20, 2026 (9:00 a.m. IST)** and ends on **Thursday, September 24, 2026 (5:00 p.m. IST)**. During this period, Members holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialized form, as on **Friday, September 18, 2026, i.e. cut-off date**, may cast their vote electronically. The e-Voting module shall be disabled by CDSL for voting thereafter.
6. The Members who have cast their vote by remote e-Voting prior to the AGM may also attend / participate in the AGM through VC / OAVM but shall not be entitled to cast their vote on such resolution again.
7. The voting rights of Members shall be in proportion to their shares in the paid-up equity share capital of the Company as on the cut-off date.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION 102 (1) OF THE COMPANIES ACT, 2013

As required by Section 102 of the Companies Act, 2013 (the "Act"), the following explanatory statement sets out all material facts relating to the Special Businesses mentioned in the accompanying Notice.

Item Nos. 3 & 4 To consider increase in borrowing limits of the Company and creation of charges

Section 180(1)(c) of the Companies Act, 2013, read with the rules made thereunder (the "Act"), provides that the Board of Directors of the Company shall not, except with the consent of the Members by way of a Special Resolution, borrow monies, together with the monies already borrowed by the Company, if any (apart from temporary loans obtained from the Company's bankers in the ordinary course of business), in excess of the aggregate of its paid-up share capital, free reserves and securities premium.

The Members of the Company, at the 40th Annual General Meeting held on September 26, 2024, authorised the Board of Directors to borrow monies up to an aggregate limit of ₹ 750 Crores.

The Company has a portfolio of producing, development and exploration assets across multiple hydrocarbon basins in India. Following the stabilisation and improvement of operations across its portfolio, the Company is now entering an important phase of investment aimed at increasing production from existing assets, accelerating development of discovered resources and pursuing high-potential exploration and appraisal opportunities within its existing portfolio.

The Company is embarking on a comprehensive, near-to-medium-term upstream oil and gas capital programme directed principally toward its core asset portfolio to scale up production, enhance resource recovery, and expand its reserve base. The planned capital projects include:

- B-80 Field: Additional development drilling, well interventions, and production optimization utilizing existing infrastructure.
- B-15 Field: Development of this existing offshore discovery involves drilling, completion, and necessary facility installations.
- PY-1 Field: Redevelopment and additional drilling to enhance gas production and optimize established processing facilities.
- Dirok Field: Production enhancement drilling alongside progressive exploration and appraisal across the broader North-East portfolio.
- North Dirok & Block-19: Phased exploration and appraisal drilling targeting high-potential asset monetization.

While a significant portion of the Company's exploration and development activities has historically been funded through internal accruals, the scale, timing, and contractual/working capital requirements of this intensive capital programme necessitate access to external funding. This will ensure financial flexibility without constraining growth based on the timing of internal cash generation.

Accordingly, the Board considers it prudent to enhance the Company's enabling borrowing limit under Section 180(1)(c) from ₹ 750 Crores to ₹ 1,000 Crores. Actual borrowings will be drawn progressively based on financial discipline and project needs.

Further, to secure these prospective short-term and/or long-term credit lines from financial institutions and lenders, the Company may be required to mortgage, charge, or hypothecate its movable and/or immovable assets, undertakings, or properties (both present and future). Such creation of security attracts the provisions of Section 180(1)(a) of the Companies Act, 2013, which also necessitates approval from the Members by way of a Special Resolution.

The Board of Directors is therefore of the view that the proposed enhancement of borrowing limits from ₹ 750 Crores to ₹ 1,000 Crores, together with the authority for creation of security, is in the long-term interest of the Company and its Members and recommends the Special Resolutions set out at Item Nos. 3 and 4 of the Notice for approval by the Members.

None of the Directors or Key Managerial Personnel of the Company, or their relatives, is concerned or interested, financially or otherwise, in the said resolutions set out at Item Nos. 3 and 4 of the Notice.

Item No. 5 To make investments, give loans, guarantees and security in excess of limits specified under Section 186 of the Companies Act, 2013

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 186 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with the Companies (Meeting of Board and its Powers) Rules, 2014 (the "Rules") (as amended from time to time), the Board of Directors of a Company can give any loan to any person or body corporate, give any guarantee or provide security in connection with a loan to any other body corporate or person; and acquire by way of subscription, purchase or otherwise, the securities of any other body corporate, any sum or sums of moneys on such terms and conditions and with or without security as the Board of Directors may think fit from time to time, which together with the loans, guarantee, security and investment given / provided / made by the Company, may go beyond the maximum permissible limit under Section 186 of the Companies Act, 2013 i.e. 60% of the paid-up capital of the Company and its free reserves and securities premium account or one hundred per cent of its free reserves and securities premium account, whichever is more, provided that if a special resolution has been passed by the shareholders of the Company to that effect.

In order to make optimum use of funds available with the Company and also to achieve long term strategic and business objectives, the Board of Directors of the Company proposes to make use of the same by making investment in other bodies corporate or granting loans, giving guarantee or providing security to other persons or other bodies corporate as and when required.

The loan(s), guarantee(s), security (ies) and investment(s), as the case may be, shall be made in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and relevant rules made thereunder.

Accordingly, as required under the provisions of Section 186 of the Act, the approval of the members is sought by way of a special resolution to enable the Board to make investment in other bodies corporate or granting loans, giving guarantee or providing security to other persons or other bodies corporate as and when required up to a limit of ₹ 300 Crores (Rupees Three Hundred Crores Only).

The above proposal is in the interest of the Company and the Board recommends the Special Resolution as set out at Item no. 5 for approval by the members of the Company.

None of the Directors or Key Managerial Personnel or their relatives, is concerned or interested, financially or otherwise, in the said resolution except to the extent of their shareholding in the Company, if any.

Item No. 6 Ratification of remuneration to Cost Auditor

The Board, based on the recommendation of the Audit Committee, approved the appointment of Mr. K. Suryanarayanan, Cost Accountant in Practice, to conduct the audit of the cost records of the Company for the financial year 2026-27 at a remuneration of ₹ 2,50,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs Fifty Thousand only) plus applicable service tax and out of pocket expenses.
